

COSM1101 - Introduction to Cosmetology

Description:	In this course students will learn basic techniques pertaining to hair, skin and nails and meet a portion of the hours required by the State Board of Cosmetology. The course content will include a brief overview of all cosmetology topics required for licensure by the State Board of Cosmetology. Upon completion, students could earn up to 75 hours (based on attendance) toward their cosmetology license.
