M State is a multi-campus, student success-driven community and technical college in northwestern Minnesota. The college serves nearly 15,000 students annually in credit-and non-credit courses, through more than 70 career and liberal arts programs offered online and at our welcoming campuses in Detroit Lakes, Fergus Falls, Moorhead and Wadena. M State also partners with local communities and businesses to help fill regional workforce needs.

MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Connecting Students to Careers

- Over 800 students participate in career readiness workshops each year to enhance their resume-building, interviewing, application and job-seeking skills.
- More than 100 employers attend networking events on campus each year.
- Handshake connects students and alumni to employers and jobs/internships, available at http://app.joinhandshake.com.

Dual Enrollment Impact

- M State saves regional PSEO students and families over \$4.8 million a year in tuition costs.
- Over 26,000 credits were earned by more than 2,600 dual credit students registered at M State in 2024 prior to their high school graduation (includes PSEO, eCampus in the High School and Concurrent Enrollment Program students).
- More than 45 high schools partner with M State for our Concurrent Enrollment Program and/or eCampus in the High School.

Funding Innovation

- Awarded \$4.2 million from the U.S. Department of Labor to expand equitable access to training for goodpaying jobs in key regional industries.
- Received \$2 million in Title III grants to support student success.
- Received \$1.63 million from the Department of Education from a congressionally directed funding application for a stateof-the-art simulation lab to train students in health careers.
- \$200,000 was awarded from the Minnesota Office of Higher Education to fund a Student Parent Support Initiative program.
- \$150,000 from the Minnesota State University and College system to support Credit for Prior Learning initiatives.

Workforce Development Solutions (WDS)

- Over 8,000 attendees participated in WDS trainings in fiscal year 2024.
- More than 200 employee trainings were conducted in partnership with over 100 businesses and industries.
- Course offerings, such as business technology, cannabis industry, CDL, electrical, EMS, fire, healthcare, mechanical, online, safety and much more.
- Continuing education credits (CEUs) available for qualifying courses.
